Distance Courses: Modalidad (En Línea - Virtual): The ones that under the course name on Campus say "En línea". You can also recognize them if on 'Fecha' it says something different from the regular term dates. Example: Fecha: Enero 13 2014 hasta Marz 07 2014

Special courses: These are courses opened only for specific groups of students.

Example: If it says: **Gaias** next to 'Campus,' only international students in that program can take the course because it is taught in the Galápagos Islands.

Night courses: Under Modalidad it says: Vespertino
