

## SR-Q02: CITY TOUR (3 hours)

At 2,800m above sea level, Quito is extended along the foot of the *Pichincha* Volcano. The journey begins with a great view of the city in San Juan Lookout; afterwards walk in the old city. The route continues towards down town Quito, visiting the colonial churches, monasteries, cloisters, chapels, streets; full of stories and legends that allow us to closely observe the structures that lush rose in the heyday of the Baroque, and inside many different samples stored in painting and sculpture that took shape in the hands of artists of the "*Escuela Quiteña*". Visit the Cathedral (XVI Century), the Presidential Palace, El Sagrario Church (XVII Century), and La Compañía de Jesus (XVII Century), one of the most beautiful baroque churches in South America, Not to be missed are the Church of San Francisco and Monastery , built a few months after the arrival of the Spaniards (XVI Century).

To conclude, you will go to the "*Panecillo*", a small hill with magnificent view which provides access to the four cardinal points of the city. Return to hotel.

## SR-Q10: CITY TOUR+ MIDDLE OF THE WORLD (5 Hours)

At 2,800m above sea level, Quito is extended along the foot of the *Pichincha* Volcano. The journey begins with a great view of the Orellana path and *Guápulo* Lookout, afterwards walk in the old city, The route continues towards down town Quito, visiting the colonial churches, monasteries, cloisters, chapels, streets; full of stories and legends that allow us to closely observe the structures that lush rose in the heyday of the Baroque, and inside many different samples stored in painting and sculpture that took shape in the hands of artists of the "*Escuela Quiteña*". Visit the Cathedral (XVI Century), the Presidential Palace, El Sagrario Church (XVII Century), and La Compañía de Jesus (XVII Century), one of the most beautiful baroque churches in South America, Not to be missed are the Church of San Francisco and Monastery , built a few months after the arrival of the Spaniards (XVI Century). To conclude, in the historical center you will go to the "Panecillo", a small hill with magnificent view which provides access to the four cardinal points of the city.

Ecuador, geographically positioned in the center of the globe, crossed by the equator, allows the visitor the experience of putting one foot in the northern hemisphere and the other in the southern hemisphere, so the country is considered the land in permanent spring. Visit the *Intiñan Museum* where it shows in a precise and a practical way the wisdom that Andean native peoples had in relation to the *Sun King*. Return to the hotel.

**SR-I01: TOUR TO OTAVALO MARKET. Full Day (Private Services 8 Hours)**

Depart from Quito through the Pan-American North Highway until arriving to Cayambe, where the passengers will have the opportunity to taste the delicious “Bizcochos de Cayambe”, a type of cracker or bread baked in a clay oven (greatly paired with local cheese or caramel sauce). Afterwards, we will make a brief stop at “Miralago”, to admire a wonderful view of Lago San Pablo, amazing views. The tour then continues to Otavalo where Otavaleños (natives) set up a market in which a bartering manner of shopping is taken place. The market hosts a variety of different handcrafted items. Then we will go to visit to the leather shops at Cotacachi. On the way to Cotacachi, we will visit a traditional workshop of Andean instruments "Ñanda Mañachi" located in Peguche. In Cotacachi you have enough time to visit the village, the shops of leather goods and free time for lunch. Return to Quito (Ask to you travel consultant, the supplement to visit Cuicocha Lake).
