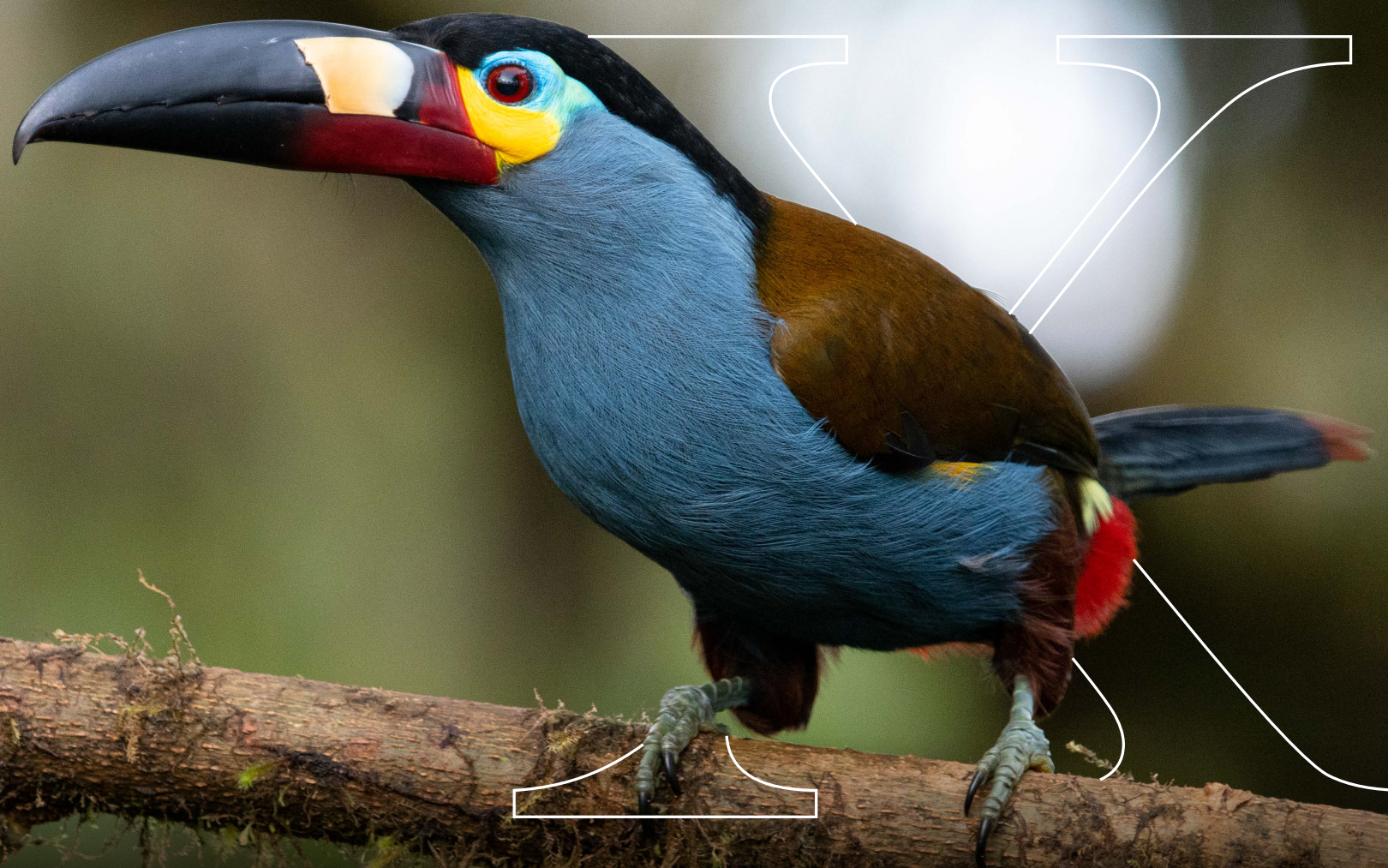

OUR GOAL

US\$ 600,000

- **Biodiversity, research & conservation:** This project aims to fund research focused on documenting, understanding, and protecting biological diversity in the Andean cloud forests.
- **Carbon compensation & Restoration:** Purchase and restore 200 ha of pasture lands currently used for cattle raising.
- **Chocó Andino** comprehends a territory of approximately 287.000 hectares, 48 % of which are remnants of Andean forest, 3.5 % constitute highlands, and 8.2% are bush ecosystems.
