Will Waters was a pillar at Universidad San Francisco de Quito USFQ, serving as one of its first deans and contributing significantly to the development of social sciences and liberal arts at the institution.

As a Sociology professor, he dedicated himself to researching and teaching methods that addressed topics such as gender, rural and urban development, differentiation without campesinization, rural bases of urban economy, social transformations, and health systems, always focusing on local participation and the study of indigenous culture. His prestige led him to collaborate with international institutions and become a member of renowned academic organizations.

Additionally, he co-directed the Institute for Health and Nutrition Research at USFQ, working alongside his wife, Wilma Freire. His legacy, marked by his scientific rigor and commitment to education, remains present at the university and in the generations he inspired.
