

<u>Visa Documents to Apply for the Temporary Resident visa in a Consulate Abroad or in Quito</u>

FBI Background check, apostilled (only US Citizens)
State Background check, apostilled (only US Citizens)
Country of citizenship background check
Insurance letter stating your name and coverage (it can be in English)
Bank Statement (it has to show your name and a minimum of \$1500, it can be
in English, but can't be older than 15 days).
USFQ Acceptance letter
Passport or wallet size picture with white background
Color copies of the passport and the entrance stamp (only if you are
applying to get the VISA in Quito)

- * Some Consulates might ask for different or more documents.
- *Make sure that you apostille the original FBI and State or Country Background checks, not the translations.
- * FBI and State Background Checks can't be older than two months.
- * Passport can't expire during the time abroad. The validity has to be 6 months after the student's departure of Ecuador
