



**Visa Documents to Apply for the Temporary Resident visa in a Consulate Abroad or in Quito**

- ☐ FBI Background check, apostilled (only US Citizens)
- ☐ State Background check, apostilled (only US Citizens)
- ☐ Country of citizenship background check
- ☐ Insurance letter stating your name and coverage (it can be in English)
- ☐ Bank Statement (it has to show your name and a minimum of \$1500, it can be in English, but can't be older than 15 days).
- ☐ USFQ Acceptance letter
- ☐ Passport or wallet size picture with white background
- ☐ Color copies of the passport and the entrance stamp (only if you are applying to get the VISA in Quito)

**\* Some Consulates might ask for different or more documents.**

\* Make sure that you apostille the original FBI and State or Country Background checks, not the translations.

\* FBI and State Background Checks can't be older than two months.

\* Passport can't expire during the time abroad. The validity has to be 6 months after the student's departure of Ecuador
